All volunteer leaders must have completed required Youth Protection Training (YPT) within one year of the last day of the Jamboree; this includes both regular YPT and Venturing YPT.

PHYSICAL FITNESS

The national jamboree is a physically demanding experience. While a lot of the site is level, there are regular changes in grade as part of everyone's daily schedule.

Obesity and being overweight have been shown to increase the likelihood of certain diseases and other health problems: hypertension, heart attack, dyslipidemia, and stroke. Our goal is to prevent any serious health-related event from occurring, and ensuring that all of our participants and staff are "physically strong."

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) is the national body that monitors our overall health as a country, and it makes recommendations to help us stay or become healthy. The CDC suggests using a body mass index as a screening tool for obesity; it is easy and only requires knowing your height and weight. The BMI is a governmental calculation based on nationwide statistics that take into account variables that include geography, age, and sex. The simple online calculator to determine your BMI can be found at www.cdc.gov/healthyweight/assessing/bmi/.

The CDC defines the BMI Healthy Weight as follows:

- If your BMI is **less than 18.5**, it falls within the "underweight" range.
- If your BMI is 18.5 to 24.9, it falls within the "normal" or Healthy Weight range.
- If your BMI is **25.0 to 29.9**, it falls within the "overweight" range.
- If your BMI is **30.0 or higher,** it falls within the "obese" range.

Upon approval by the Office of Scouting Ministry, select one of the three options listed and visit the BSA link listed above (or visit www.MyScouting.org) to get officially registered and pay your fees.
